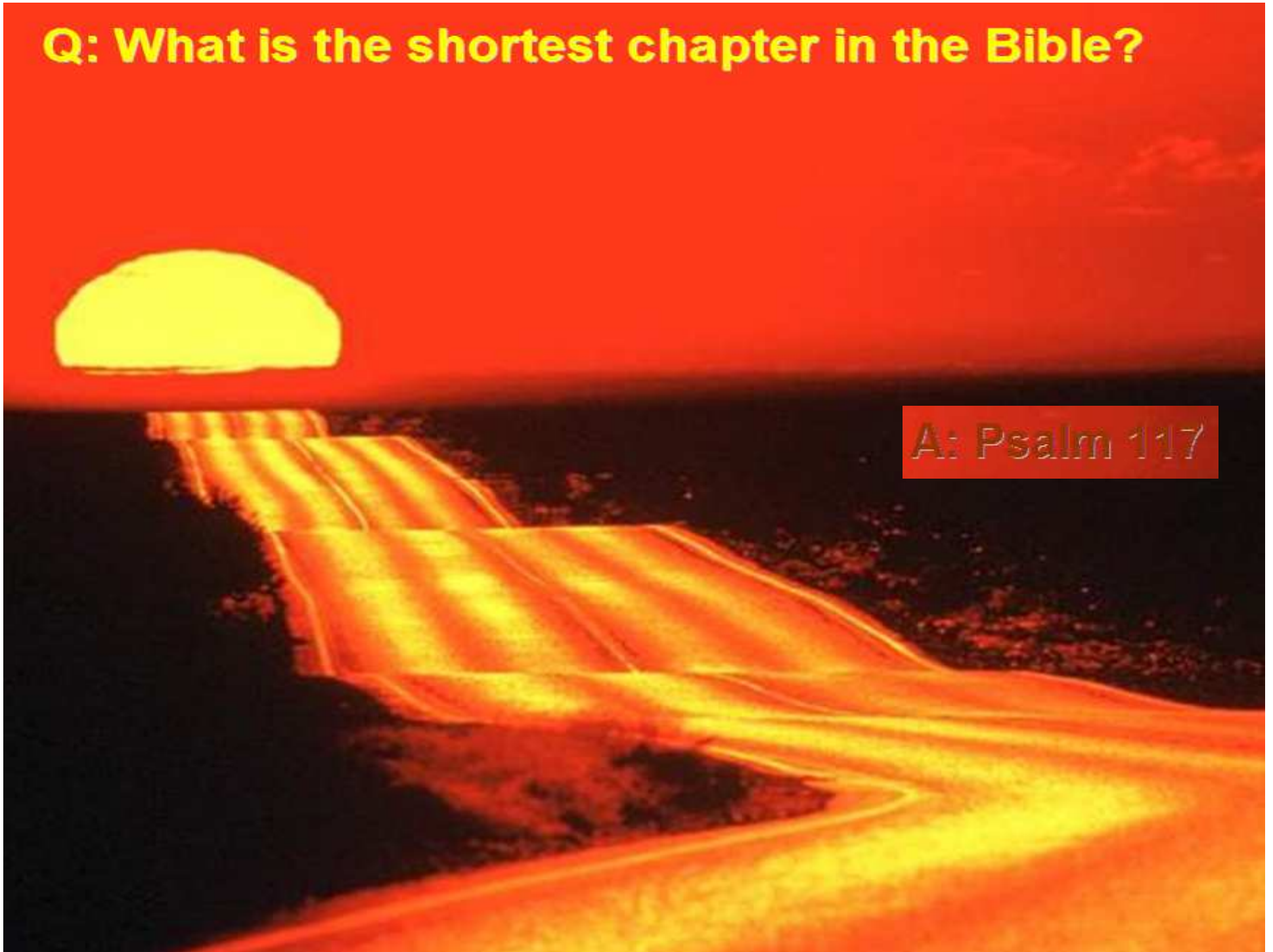


**This is pretty strange how it worked out this way.

Q: What is the shortest chapter in the Bible?


A: Psalm 117
